- **Outcome-based Process:** Develop capacity and coherence of K-14 systems with student learning needs that engages school district, county office and college educators in collaboration, co-learning and shared accountability for the sustainable improvement of student learning and achievement.
- **Focusing Direction** – Setting the stage for long-term growth of student achievement by focusing on a few goals and outcomes that align critical supports for college and career pathways.
- **Cultivating Collaborative Cultures** – Implementing structures and processes that engage educators at the school district, county office and college levels in systematic collaboration and shared leadership for the continuous improvement of student learning.
- **Deepening Learning** – Implementing a coherent K-14 instructional program with systems of support for the continuous growth of critical student skills and competencies.
- **Securing Accountability** – Creating a common vision of accountability that engages school district, county office and college educators in collaboratively monitoring evidence of student learning to continuously adapt and improve student tasks, instructional supports and college and career pathways.



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### **February 7<sup>th</sup> Session**

**Location: Pleasant Hill Community Center, 320 Civic Drive, Pleasant Hill**

**8:30am – 1pm (includes lunch and time for team collaboration)**

**Focus:** Define the key goals and outcomes, instructional priorities, collaborative structures, and evidence of impact that will inform systems coherence and capacity building.

**Process:** Teams will be led through a collaborative process to communicate improvement strategies at all levels, define action steps, and establish processes for monitoring progress and impact to guide continuous improvement.

**Outcomes:** Teams will complete a 90 day action plan aligned with priorities that will guide the interim work. Teams will be asked to share progress and impact at the March 2017 session.

### **March 30<sup>th</sup> Session**

**Location: Pleasant Hill Community Center, 320 Civic Drive, Pleasant Hill**

**8:30am – 1pm (includes lunch and time for team collaboration)**

**Focus:** Create structures and processes for K-14 collaboration to monitor evidence of student learning and continuously adapt and improve student tasks, instructional supports and college and career pathways.

**Process:** Teams will be led through a collaborative process to establish the structures, supports and practices needed to develop the collective capacity to lead continuous improvement of student learning.

**Outcomes:** Teams will refine the 90 day action plan to guide interim district work. Teams will be asked to share progress and impact at the May 2017 session.

### **May 24<sup>th</sup> Session**

**Location: San Ramon Community Center, 12501 Alcosta Blvd., San Ramon**

**8:30am – 1pm (includes lunch and time for team collaboration)**

**Focus:** Teams will share progress, impact and promising practices for leading continuous improvement of college and career pathways and student support systems.

**Process:** Teams will engage in small group sharing opportunities and whole group presentations of promising practices to further build collective capacity of regional partners.

**Outcomes:** Teams sharing of progress, impact and promising practices will assist in defining the focus for 2017-18 to further develop college and career pathways and student support systems.
